ALINGHI'S HISTORIC AMERICA'S CUP WIN
& DUNKERBECK'S SPEED SAILING RECORD ATTEMPT
WITH CNN'S 'INSIDE SAILING'

**Airs Sunday March 16th at 2130,
Wednesday March 19th at 1830 and Saturday March 22nd at 1930 CET**

This month 'Inside Sailing' visits the America's Cup in Auckland, New Zealand. Presenter Lou James reports on Alinghi's historic win which will bring the Cup back to Europe for the first time since it was raced off Cowes in 1851.

As more and more sailing records are being broken, 'Inside Sailing' looks at plans for an attempt on the outright world speed sailing record – by a windsurfer! The current record of 46 knots was set by the radical proa Yellow Pages Endeavour, in Australia, ten years ago. Since then there have been many attempts to break this record and that elusive 50-knot barrier, but all have failed. Now thirteen times world windsurfing champion, Bjorn Dunkerbeck will make his assault.
